Nightrider is an annual charity fundraising cycle ride touring London at night, this year being our 10th anniversary and operated on 8/9 June. Thousands of riders challenge themselves to complete 100km including some of the highest, busiest and most iconic parts of the city, raising over £1 million for many different causes.

In 2019, as every year, the start and finish will be at the Lee Valley Velopark, and we are contacting you to inform you that the event is happening, and to let you know who to call if we disturb you. Whilst we do ask all our participants to remember that London is a living city and to be aware and considerate, understandably many are likely to be quite excited and may need to be reminded!

The start area will be located on the plaza in front of the Velodrome, and the finish behind the it, between the building and the A12

Our start process releases the riders in groups between 2230 and midnight on 8 June, so we will need to make some announcements during that period, which we will do at as low a volume as possible. The first riders may return from about 0300 on 9 June with the last by 1000 – we do not plan to use the PA to make any announcements during this period. Before and during the start process we do plan to have some background music; again, this will not be at a high volume, so please let us know if it is disturbing you.
